Dear Parents,

The Committee wishes all our members the very best for 2010. This letter is to inform you, the members on how we see the new season ahead, and some changes that will effect you and your children. Firstly we must highlight the changes regarding training and the preseason for all teams in 2010. While the teams may have a staggered start with training and some teams may start before registration day the aim of the committee is to see a smooth start for all.

The new ground is the best playing and training facility anywhere in the western suburbs. The management plan on how the ground will be used by the community and our club has been finalised, although it has taken a lot longer time than expected. The club will soon be signing off on the usage agreement with council for the hours that this club needs and requires for all teams to train and play every year at the Grange Reserve.

The nuts and bolts of 2010

Main ground: has been given a full reconstruction (no more sand)

New artificial ground: is operational and fantastic.

Each age group or team will be allocated training times and nights of the week once all coaches have requested their preferred training nights and council agreement is signed off for all teams to start While the club must also fit in all age groups we still have only one training ground for the club and 15 users.

This will require coaches and managers assisting each other and recognising each other's needs.

The club would normally have contacted all its members earlier with general information and registration day & date our apologies for the delays.

Registration Day is Sunday 7th February between 9.30am and 1.00pm.

Fees: 2010 will see increases to all fees for all players in line with the FFA & FFV increases and club running costs. The new lighting system on the synthetic pitch also has a direct power cost impact per playing member for the season.
